



Ken Arutyunyan is a promoter, manager, and trainer born in Yerevan, Armenia. Ken studied wrestling, boxing, judo, sambo, and san shou during his adolescent and teenage years. He assisted promoters in promoting a show called 'Shoot Boxing' in Japan while his students competed in the Tokyo Dome multiple times. Ken is a master of the art and primarily teaches boxing, ensuring his students remain injury-free and helping them become champions.

**In 1992**, Ken Arutyunyan became the first person to promote **Draka**, Russian, for free sparring, for amateur and professional rules. He collaborated with the California Athletic Commissioner to establish the rules for mixed martial arts and introduced the new sport in the US. This paved the way for the first-ever mixed martial fight between the USA and Russia on June 27th, 1992, at the **UNLV Bren Center in Irvine, California**. The event received national recognition, with Ken Arutyunyan serving as the Coach and Manager of the Russian team, while **Ruben Urquidez** managed the American team.

In 2016, two of Ken's students, Ferdinand Kerobian and Vardges Vardanyan, qualified for the USA national team's group of eight. Ken organized five of the most significant fighting shows in the Great Western Forum, while others took place at the Olympic Auditorium and Occidental College. He has promoted shows worldwide, including Russia, Armenia, and Kyrgyzstan. The International Sport Union is recognized by respected organizations such as the California Athletic Commission, the USA Boxing Federation, the USA Wrestling Organization, and the California District Officials.

Dan Moses, Partner at ISU and Ken's student. I was born and raised in Los Angeles, CA. I've been working at my older brother's gym, at Moses Fitness, under his mentorship for 8 years; mentoring in Bodybuilding, nutrition coaching, programming, powerlifting, skiing, and rock climbing are all at advanced levels. I then joined and graduated from NHI, a massage therapy school, graduating as a licensed massage therapist. I have been working since I was 16, starting as a janitor and helping hand, slowly moving up over the years to manage the business. I acquired the necessary skills to work with Ken, with whom I am now honored to be in business as his business manager and spokesman.

The quality of sportsmanship and coaching is unparalleled at any other facility and is a community pillar. You can see it when you join, which made me invest in the partnership.

I found ISU and met Ken; it was something I heard of by word of mouth by many in my community. When I started training with Ken, I was instantly humbled by the truth of being a fighter. He trained me privately and in a class setting for only a year and a half before I could go toe to toe with professional fighters who wanted to teach me instead of breaking me.

As a student of Ken, I have put in the hours and listened to his coaching. If you come to ISU, you're ready to transform into the most confident version of yourself and create the discipline your life needs. If you can get through a session, you can get through your day. All the coaches here will build you up and teach you to stay injury-free.
